



## Separation Calculation Request Form

If a separation has occurred, a former spouse or common-law partner may have an entitlement to pension benefits accrued during the relationship. They can also agree to not divide the pension. We can calculate the pension accrued during the period of the relationship and send a statement of possible pension entitlements. Either party or their respective legal counsel can request a calculation.
